russian winter wonderland

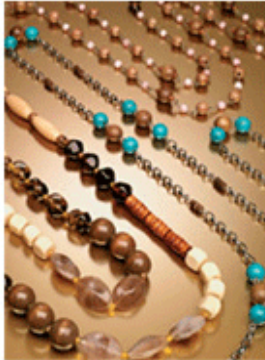
